**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SEGUIN  
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (SEDC) AND TRC ENGINEERS, INC.  
FOR THE DESIGN OF A WATER LINE TO SERVE THE NEWQUEST DEVELOPMENT;  
AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (“SEDC”), along with the City of Seguin, Texas (“City”), have encouraged and supported what is commonly known as the NewQuest development, located within the corporate limits of the City of Seguin between IH-10 and FM 78; and

**WHEREAS**, as a way to fulfill part of its development needs, NewQuest has requested water utilities from Springs Hill Water Supply Corporation, which has limited capacity to meet NewQuest’s anticipated demand; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has sufficient water capacity to meet NewQuest’s demand for water utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff and the Board of Directors of SEDC have concluded that development of a water line extension to enable the City to serve the NewQuest development is recommended and is in the best interests of the City, the SEDC, developers, and the citizens of the City of Seguin; and

**WHEREAS**, staff believes that TRC Engineers, Inc. is the best qualified firm to perform engineering services for design of the water line extension, and recommends execution of an engineering services contract in an amount not to exceed \$550,458.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** That all the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if restated in full.

**SECTION 2.** That execution of a contract between SEDC and TRC Engineers, Inc. for the design of a water line extension to the NewQuest development in an amount not to exceed \$550,458 is hereby authorized.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
