CITY OF SEGUIN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, LIFTING THE TWO-HOUR TIME LIMIT PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE 200 BLOCK OF EAST DONEGAN STREET, THE NORTHERN HALF OF THE WEST SIDE OF THE 200 BLOCK OF SOUTH CAMP STREET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, currently the north side of the 200 block of East Donegan and the northern half of the West side of the 200 block of South Camp (spaces north of Bender's Realty) are restricted 2-hour parking; and

WHEREAS, after discussions with Guadalupe County officials regarding the need for more all-day parking to serve the courthouse, the Main Street Advisory Board met and approved the conversion; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street Advisory Board met and considered the requests to remove time limited parking and recommended lifting the two hour parking limitation on the east side of the north side of the 200 block of East Donegan Street and on the northern half of the west side of the 200 block of South Camp Street as illustrated on the attached map.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART ONE. The two-hour restricted parking limitation for the north side of the 200 block of East Donegan Street is hereby lifted.

PART TWO. The two-hour restricted parking limitation for the northern half of the west side of the 200 block of South Camp Street is hereby lifted.

PART THREE. City staff is hereby directed to remove the two-hour limited parking signs for the above referenced blocks in accordance with this ordinance.
