A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,956,321.88 WITH PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS FOR THE GUADALUPE STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City wishes to improve roadways through reconstruction to improve safety, access and mobility for people of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Street Reconstruction project includes drainage, utility, pedestrian and roadway improvements.

WHEREAS, the City's 5-year Street and Drainage Projects Plan identifies reconstruction of Guadalupe Street from IH-10 to the Union Pacific Railroad; and

WHEREAS, the services to be performed by Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project include planning, engineering, surveying, geotechnical, bidding and construction phase services; and

WHEREAS, City staff have negotiated a professional services agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends entering into a professional services agreement for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$1,956,321.88 with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Guadalupe Street Reconstruction Project.

Section 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute an agreement with Pape-Dawson for the Guadalupe Street Reconstruction Project for the base fee of \$1,641,418.88.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute service amendments within contingency as allowed, up to \$314,903.00 for a total amount of \$1,956,321.88.

Section 4. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
