AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 102, UTILITIES, AMENDING APPENDIX C – FEE SCHEDULE, CHAPTER 102, UTILITIES, ARTICLE III, WATER RATES; AND ARTICLE IV, WASTEWATER RATES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, in preparation for the budget the City reviews its water and wastewater utility studies to adjust the five-year plan; and

WHEREAS, the addition of extended sewer service and potential new customers along with wholesale sales of water are having a positive effect on the City's rate structure; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the initial stages of developing plans for the upgrade and expansion of the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the rates proposed by this Ordinance are consistent with the aforementioned studies.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. Chapter 102, Utilities, Article III, Water, Subsections f, g, and h (rest of section and subsections remain the same) is amended as follows (<u>underlining</u> indicates added text, strikethrough indicates deleted text):
