CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE TEXAS OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND COUNCIL FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT COMMUNITY-BASED OPIOID RECOVERY EFFORT (CORE) MULTI-YEAR GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Seguin, TX that a Community Paramedic Program be operated for the FY2027, FY2028, and FY2029; and

WHEREAS, City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council grant application; and

WHEREAS, City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council funds, City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council in full.

WHEREAS, City Council designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, City Council designates the City Grants Administrator as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on the behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council approved submission of the grant application for a Community Paramedic Program to the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
