**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AWARDING A BID TO M&C FONSECA CONSTRUCTION FOR THE HUBER ROAD 24
INCH SANITARY SEWER PROJECT AND APPROVING STAFF’S NEGOTIATION A
CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,281,389.75 FOR THAT PROJECT;
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NEGOTIATED CONTRACT;
AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Huber Road 24 inch Sanitary Sewer Project (the “Project”) consists of approximately 6700 linear feet of gravity sewer main running along Huber Road from the north side of IH-10 to Rudeloff Road; and

WHEREAS, fifteen companies submitted responses to the City’s request for proposals to construct the Project; and

WHEREAS, the bids ranged from a low bid of \$1,282,389.74 from the M&C Fonseca Construction of Granite Shoals to a high base bid of \$2,171.646.08 from E-Z Bel Construction of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, city staff, along with the City’s Project design engineer Beau Perry of TRC, reviewed the bids and the references of the bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects and bid amount city staff recommends awarding the bid to the low bidder, M&C Fonseca Construction; and

WHEREAS, city staff will negotiate a standard form contact in an amount not to exceed \$1,281,389.75 for execution by M&C Fonseca Construction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. M&C Fonseca Construction is awarded the bid in an amount not to exceed \$1,281,389.75 for the Huber Road 24 inch Sanitary Sewer Project.

SECTION 2. The city manager is authorized to execute a standard form contract with M&C Fonseca Construction for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
