## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY DENISE IMHOFF FOR ONE PARCEL OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID 66007 ALONG US HWY 90 EAST, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Denise Imhoff filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for one parcel of land with Property ID 66007, totaling approximately 1.35 acres along US Hwy 90 East in Kingsbury, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, Denise Imhoff has presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the Petition submitted by Denise Imhoff meets the requisites of the new law.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

- **PART 1.** The Petition for release of one parcel of land owned by Denise Imhoff is accepted.
- **PART 2.** The parcel of land being 1.35 acres situated in the J. H. Kuykendall Survey, A-199, Property ID 66007; and as more particularly described in the attached metes and bounds description, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.
- **PART 3.** City staff is hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- **PART 4.** This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning October 3, 2023.
