RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS (TDHCA) COMMUNITY DEVELOLPMENT BLOCK GRANT CARES ACT (CDBG-CV) FOR THE COMMUNITY RESILIENCY PROGRAM GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE AND AUTHORIZED SIGNATORY IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS,** TDHCA has targeted funds for projects serving low-and-moderate income areas to prepare, prevent and respond to the social and economic impacts of coronavirus and to improve access to social services and healthcare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin is an eligible applicant as a non-entitlement unit of general local government; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Seguin to apply for funding to acquire two EMS vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager will act as the City's Authorized Representative and Authorized Signatory in all matters pertaining to this grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1**: That an application is hereby authorized to be submitted on behalf of the City of Seguin to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs CDBG-CV for the Community Resiliency Program grant.

**SECTION 2**: That the application be for up to \$500,000 of grant funds to provide two EMS vehicles, with no matching funds required.

**SECTION 3:** That the City Manager is designated as the Authorized Representative and Authorized Signatory to act in all matters in connection with this application and participation in this grant program.
