

STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS DECLARING THAT SIXTY-EIGHT MOTOROLA HAND-HELD RADIOS ARE OBSOLETE AND THEREFORE SURPLUS; TRANSFERRING 10 OF THE OBSOLETE UNITS TO THE NIXON POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR USE BY THEIR POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Seguin Police Department has sixty-eight (68) outdated Motorola handheld radios that are no longer compatible with the newer equipment used by the Department and is now surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Nixon Police Department has submitted a request for the donation of ten radios that are still operational to be strictly used for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, donating ten radios to another law enforcement agency benefits the public; and

WHEREAS, the remaining fifty-eight radios will be placed on GovDeals.com to be sold to the highest bidder.

NOT THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas that:

SECTION 1. The sixty-eight Motorola hand-held radios are no longer of use to the City’s police department and are hereby declared as surplus property.

SECTION 2. The equipment set out above in Section 1 is of limited monetary value.

SECTION 3. It is in the best interest of the public to donate ten operational radios to the Nixon Police Department for law enforcement purposes, with the remainder consigned to the online auction.

SECTION 4. This resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
