CITY OF SEGUIN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SEGUIN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT ON CORDOVA ROAD FROM THE 35 MPH ZONE NEAR STATE HIGHWAY 46 TO THE 35 MPH ZONE NEAR STATE HIGHWAY 123, WITHIN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PREPARE THIS ORDINANCE FOR SUBMISSION AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

**WHEREAS**, the city engineering staff has conducted an engineering and traffic investigation of Cordova Road from SH 46 to SH 123; and

**WHEREAS**, given the level of development and number of heavy trucks serving that development the investigation supports lowering the speed limit from 50 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, for a distance of 1,200 feet from the center of the intersection of Cordova Road and SH 46 and 1700 feet from the intersection of Cordova Road and SH123 the current speed limit is 35 mph, which should remain.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin as follows:

**Part One.** The first three recitals set forth above are hereby adopted, in full, as part of this Ordinance.

**Part Two.** Section 98-65(b) of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances is amended by adding new subsection (13), Cordova Road (all remaining parts of 98-65 shall remain the same) which will read as follows:

(1) *Cordova Road*, from SH 46 to a point 1200 feet from the intersection.... 35 mph;  
from the point 1200 feet from SH46 to a point 1700 feet from SH123, (2.83 miles) ..... 45 mph  
From the point 1700 feet from SH123 to the intersection.....35 mph

**Part Three.** The City's Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to install signage in accordance with this Ordinance.

**Part Four.** Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.

**Part. Five.** If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

**Part Six.** City staff is authorized to prepare this Ordinance for submission as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.

**Part Seven.** In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following its passage and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
