Re: Naming of Schertz Seguin Local Government Corporation Facility

As you are well aware, Rodger Weyel served on the Seguin City Council for over 44 years. With his recent passing we have received a request for naming a facility in his honor. Please see the attached request. During his time on City Council I understand that he had an interest in the adequacy of the City's drinking water supply. In the late 1990's he was a strong supporter of the initiative of developing an alternate water supply, and ultimately supporting the development of the Schertz Seguin Local Government Corporation (SSLGC). The SSLGC was formed to provide an alternate water supply to both the Cities of Schertz and Seguin.

The SSLGC recently adopted a policy on considering the naming of their facilities which includes nominations being made by the City Councils of Schertz and Seguin. Considering this, I would recommend that the Terminus Building located at the City of Seguin Water Plant be named the Rodger Weyel Building. Please see the attached photo of the facility. The Terminus Building is an integral part of the SSLGC system and is critical to the City of Seguin's water supply. This building is the permanent point of delivery from the over \$100 million SSLGC water project to the City of Seguin in order that we may serve our citizens, businesses, and industries for generations to come.
