A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN APPROVING FUNDING FOR THE SEBASTOPOL HOUSE PORCH REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, during the solicitation process for bids to restore the Sebastopol House porch, it was found that the bids received were over the initially allocated budget for the project; and

WHEREAS, despite the unexpected increase in cost, it is imperative to proceed with the restoration as soon as possible to preserve the historic integrity of the Sebastopol House; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received, both of which exceed the current budget, as detailed in the attached bid tabulation; and

WHEREAS, the Sebastopol House is a significant historical landmark in our community, and the porch is currently a safety issue and in critical need of restoration to prevent further deterioration; and

WHEREAS, delaying this project could result in more extensive damage, potentially leading to higher repair costs in the future and a loss of historical value; and

WHEREAS, given the higher-than-expected bids, a budget amendment is necessary to cover the additional costs; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding the contract to Phoenix I Restoration and Construction, LLC., who submitted the lowest qualified bid of \$109,800, based on their reputation for quality work and their ability to complete the project in a timely manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF [CITY NAME]:

- 1. The contract for the restoration of the Sebastopol House porch is awarded to Phoenix I Restoration and Construction, LLC., in the amount of \$109,800.
- 2. The City Manager, or their designee, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to effectuate this resolution.
