A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING A MASTER EQUITY LEASE AGREEMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT TRUST FOR A PILOT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE VEHICLES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE USE BY CITY STAFF; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH THE PROGRAM; AND PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, city staff has been reviewing different ways to improve the quality of its fleet system while keeping costs down; and

WHEREAS, other cities in the area utilize a lease management system wherein the cities lease vehicles for a period of three to five years with a sale or buyout option at the end of the lease term; and

WHEREAS, some of the current administrative vehicles are ten years old with increasing costs for maintenance and decreasing fuel efficiency; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing programs and discussions with Enterprise Fleet Management city staff recommends beginning a pilot program with Enterprise to replace 11 administrative vehicles over a four year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas as follows:

PART ONE: The City Council hereby approves the attached Master Equity Lease Agreement and the Maintenance Agreement, along with the attached amendments, to establish a fleet vehicle lease program with Enterprise Fleet Management Trust.

PART TWO: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached documents with Enterprise Fleet Management Trust.
