**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SEGUIN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION AT THE INTERSECTION AT ZORN STREET AND SAUNDERS STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS,** Zorn Street at its intersection with Saunders Street is presently controlled by a yield sign; and

**WHEREAS,** the intersection does not meet the requirements for a yield sign; and

**WHEREAS,** the intersection of Zorn Street at Saunders Street does meet the warrants for a stop intersection; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good of the government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

1. A Stop Intersection is hereby created at the intersection of Zorn Street and Saunders Street within the City of Seguin:
2. The City's Public Works Manager is hereby authorized to designate the intersection of Zorn Street at Saunders Street as a Stop Intersection in accordance with this Ordinance, and is further directed to erect appropriate signs or other markings giving notice thereof:
3. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.
4. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.

5. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.
