A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FUQUAY, INC. FOR THE WOODLAND DRIVE UTILITY REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO INCLUDE VARIOUS APPURTENANCES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FUQUAY, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Public Works department has plans to improve the street conditions along Woodland Drive; and

WHEREAS, to stay ahead of their work, the Utilities department will be replacing utilities along this street; and

WHEREAS, a proposal was obtained from Fuquay, Inc. to install new 8-inch water and wastewater mains based on contract prices from the purchasing cooperative known as BuyBoard; and

WHEREAS, BuyBoard is a national purchasing cooperative administered by the State of Texas and purchases utilizing BuyBoard contracts comply with Texas bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends accepting the proposal of \$963,795.12 submitted by Fuquay, Inc. plus \$36,204.88 in contingency for a total amount of \$1,000,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves the proposal submitted by Fuquay, Inc. in the amount of \$963,795.12 for the installation of the new 8-inch water and wastewater mains for the Woodland Drive Utility Replacement Project to include various appurtenances, plus \$36,204.88 in contingency for a total amount of \$1,000,000.00.

Part 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Fuquay, Inc., for the for the installation of the new 8-inch water and wastewater mains for the Woodland Drive Utility Replacement Project to include various appurtenances.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
