AN AMENDED RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,000.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR A FY2019 LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2018, the City Council approved the application to the Office of the Governor for a grant through the then named Border Star Program; and

WHEREAS, the police department sought funding to cover the additional overtime costs for interdiction along IH-10 as well as State Highways 46 and 123; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has conditionally approved a FY 2019 Border Star Grant in the amount of \$18,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to accept a grant from the Office of the Governor for the Local Border Security Program.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate and act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor Funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
