A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TRC ENGINEERING FOR THE WALNUT BRANCH-GERONIMO CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT TO ADD ADDITIONAL SERVICES REQUIRED BY THE PRELIMINARY ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in July 2020, City Council amended the 2019 two-stage professional services agreement with TRC engineering to begin the design of the expansion of the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant to include additional capacity and a third and final stage to decommission the Walnut Branch Wastewater Treatment Plan; and

WHEREAS, the addition of the third stage to the TRC Contract, the Texas Historical Commission response to TRC's initial submittal, requirements for crossing the Guadalupe River and areas subject to the U.S. Corps of Engineers reforestation project with the City, permits for the two river crossings and asbestos and lead surveys for the existing wastewater treatment plants presents the need for additional environmental assessments and related services; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the additional environmental services and permits will be \$128,466.00; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends amending the Professional Services Agreement with TRC to include the additional environmental work needed for the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves amending the existing contract with TRC Engineering in the amount of \$128,466.00 to include additional environmental services.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with TRC Solutions for the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant to include expanded services necessary for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
