A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS URGING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT AN APPROPRIATE STUDY AND INSTALL A SIGNAL LIGHT AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 123 NORTH AT MARTINDALE ROAD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, as the traffic on Highway 123 North has greatly increased; and

WHEREAS, the intersection at Highway 123 North and Martindale Road has become heavily making it more dangerous for the large number of persons circumventing the area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Seguin, Texas is concerned for the safety of its citizens as well as the safety of those visiting or passing through the City.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

PART 1. The City Council requests that the Texas Department of Transportation, after conducting the appropriate study, place a signal light at the intersection of State Highway 123 North and Martindale Road.

PART 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
