Re: Agreement for Professional Engineering Services
Rio Nogales Reconstruction and Eighth Street Construction (SIRO)

In preparation for the recently announced location of the first SIRO manufacturing plant in the United States, the City of Seguin (City) needs to ensure that sufficient street infrastructure is constructed to assure adequate access to and from the identified SIRO site. The City has requested a design proposal from TRC Solutions, to ensure the timely design and subsequent construction of the necessary street improvements.

TRC Solutions has provided the attached proposal for topographical surveying, geotechnical services and associated engineering services for the upgrading of the Guadalupe/Rio Nogales intersection, upgrading of Rio Nogales Drive, upgrading the Rio Nogales/Eighth Street intersection and the construction of Eighth Street from Rio Nogales to the access point for the Siro plant, approximately 600-feet in length. Rio Nogales will remain a 32-foot wide section and Eighth Street will be constructed to a 42-foot wide section.

Attached is TRC's proposal in the amount of \$114,263. Staff recommends approval of the engineering proposal from TRC in the amount of \$114,263, for the surveying, geotechnical investigation and report and design of improvements, as stated above.

Funds for the project are included in the enclosed General Fund Budget Adjustment in the amount of \$57,131.50, which represents half of this fee. The remaining half of the fee will be funded by SEDC and will be presented for approval at their next Board meeting.
