A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR HOMELAND SECURITY DIVISION FOR AN OPERATION BORDER STAR GRANT TO ASSIST IN FUNDING POLICE OVERTIME; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the police department has previously received a grant to assist in providing additional manpower along IH-10 for drug and weapon interdiction; and

WHEREAS, the police department is seeking another grant, in the amount of \$21,000.00 to cover additional overtime costs for increased manpower for drug and weapon interdiction on IH-10 as well as State Highways 46 and 123; and

WHEREAS, matching funds are not required for this grant; and

WHEREAS, city staff requests approval for the submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor Division of Homeland Security, Operation Border Star.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
