

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH GUADALUPE COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES TO THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS ADJACENT TO THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID ONE-YEAR CONTRACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin (the "City") has a long-standing partnership with Guadalupe County (the "County") to provide essential fire protection services to the unincorporated areas surrounding the City; and

WHEREAS, this cooperative relationship is authorized under Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, which permits local governments to enter into interlocal agreements for the efficient sharing of services, facilities, and responsibilities for the mutual benefit of their citizens; and

WHEREAS, the current Interlocal Agreement is scheduled for renewal, and the Seguin Fire Department has continued to provide excellent service to the residents of Guadalupe County under the terms of the existing agreement; and

WHEREAS, the renewal contract stipulates that Guadalupe County shall remit an annual sum of Four Hundred Thirty Thousand, Eight Hundred Sixty-Two and 00/100 Dollars (\$430,862.00) to the City of Seguin for the first year of the renewed agreement, structured as monthly payments of Thirty-Five Thousand, Nine Hundred Five and 16/100 Dollars (\$35,905.16); and

WHEREAS, the Staff of the City of Seguin recommends the approval and renewal of this vital Interlocal Agreement to maintain the continuity of fire protection services for the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

Part 1. The City Council hereby approves the renewal of the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Seguin and Guadalupe County for the provision of fire protection services in the unincorporated areas surrounding the City.

Part 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the one-year renewal contract with Guadalupe County, ensuring that the terms of the agreement conform to the financial terms outlined in this Resolution.

Part 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
