## **CITY OF SEGUIN**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) OFFICE

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice is currently seeking applications for the 2020 COPS Hiring Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin Police Department seeks to submit an application to fund two Student Resource Officers on Seguin Independent School District campuses; and

**WHEREAS**, the two Student Resource Officers would be hired for a term of three years with \$250,000 awarded funds, requiring a match of no more than \$233,776, for a total program cost of \$483,776; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, Seguin Independent School District would enter into an agreement to share 25% of the required match; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1**: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the U.S. Department of Justice for the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant.

**SECTION 2**: The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Official Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
