## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE PROTECT IT GRANT PROGRAM FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEMS IN THE DOWNTOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, due, in part, to density and common wall buildings and businesses in downtown historic districts, including Seguin's, are at higher risk for loss by fire than in other, newer, districts in the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of installing modern fire suppression systems in older buildings can hinder development, particularly development of living spaces on the second floor; and

**WHEREAS**, since historic buildings are an asset to a city many cities provide grants to partially fund the addition of a fire suppression system in the historic building; and

**WHEREAS**, by protecting the downtown historic district and the viability of the downtown the citizens of Seguin will benefit from this program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** The City Council hereby approves the "Protect It" Grant Program outlined in the attached Exhibit "A.".

**PART TWO.** All applicants will be required to submit the attached application, provide the required information, and use a contractor licensed by the state for fire sprinkler installation.

**PART THREE.** Once approved the Grant will be based on the square foot of building space covered by the system as set forth in the attached Program.

**PART FOUR.** This resolution is in effect on and after the date of its passage.
