## **CITY OF SEGUIN**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM – MITIGATION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City's Information Technology department has the responsibility to mitigate and reduce cybersecurity risks and respond to, and recover from cybersecurity threats to information systems owned and operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grants Division has announced a State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program for FY2025-2026 to provide funding for projects that supports local governments with managing and reducing systemic cyber risks; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is submitting a grant application with a funding request not to exceed \$168,000, with 20% matching funds required, in response to this grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the City.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,

- 1. The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grants Division.
- 2. The City of Seguin directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and City's participation in the Grant Program.
- 3. Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Homeland Security Grants Division guidelines, terms and condition of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Office of the Governor Public Safety Office.
- 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
