Re: Guadalupe County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan

In February of 2020, the City of Seguin, along with Guadalupe County and the City of Cibolo, contracted with H2O Partners to revise the County's Hazard Mitigation Action Plan. FEMA requires that communities update hazard mitigation action plans every five years in order to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes. The Hazard Mitigation Plan is the assessment of the City's and County's potential risks and hazards outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards that threaten the community.
