CITY OF SEGUIN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, LIFTING THE TWO-HOUR TIME LIMIT PARKING IN THE 100 BLOCK OF EAST COURT STREET FOR THE DURATION OF THE RENOVATION OF THE GUADALUPE COUNTY COURTHOUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe County Courthouse is undergoing renovations to restore the building so that it can serve the needs of the County including use by the Commissioner's Court; and

WHEREAS, during the time that the renovations are taking place as well as after the building becomes operational there will be a need for all day parking for the persons performing the work on the Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the County has requested that the county officials parking on the north side of the 100 block of East Donegan be maintained as well as the sheriff's parking on the east side of the 100 block of South Austin Street; and

WHEREAS, the County also requested to have the two-hour restricted parking removed from the 100 block of East Court and the 100 block of South River; and

WHEREAS, due to the presence of retail merchants on South River that need parking turnover, the Main Street Advisory Board recommends granting the County's request with respect to the 100 block of East Court and maintaining the current restricted parking for County officials and the Sheriff's department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART ONE. The two-hour restricted parking limitation for the 100 block of East Court is hereby lifted.

PART TWO. City staff is hereby directed to remove or cover the two-hour limited parking signs for the 100 Block of East Court in accordance with this ordinance.
