RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING STAFF TO MOVE FORWARD WITH A GOLF COURSE RENOVATION PLAN UTILIZING ROSS GOLF DESIGN TO DEVELOP AN INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR EACH RESPECTIVE ELEMENT OF RENOVATION; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO BEGIN INTEGRATING THE RENOVATION COST ESTIMATES INTO A PAYMENT SCHEDULE THAT ACCOMMODATES THE COST OF RENOVATIONS AND OPERATIONS LOSSES DURING THE RENOVATION PERIOD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City contracted with the National Gold Foundation ("NGF") in 2022 to assess the Starcke Golf Course, which resulted in NGF's recommendation of a comprehensive renovation; and

WHEREAS, Seguin City Council subsequently approved a contract with Ross Golf Design to create a comprehensive renovation plan; and

WHEREAS, Ross Golf Design returned a design and preliminary cost estimate in November 2023, totaling \$8,787,471; and

WHEREAS, in further consideration of the renovation recommendation, the City Council and the Golf Course Advisory Board jointly held a public workshop on January 19, 2024, receiving generally positive feedback; and

WHEREAS, the City has received several letters of support from local and national entities that utilize Starcke Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, staff recommend approval of Ross Golf Design's renovation plan and recommend moving forward with renovations in the coming months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. Staff is authorized to move forward with a golf course renovation plan utilizing Ross Golf Design to develop an Invitation for Bids for each respective element of renovation; and .

Part 2. the Director of Finance is authorized to begin integrating the renovation cost estimates into a payment schedule that accommodates the cost of renovations and operations losses during the renovation period; and

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
