ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 42, EMERGENCY SERVICES, APPENDIX C - FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PREPARING THIS ORDINANCE FOR PUBLICATION; AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Seguin Fire Department has indicated a need to amend certain fees associated with Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, Staff has reviewed and made recommendations regarding modifications to the fee schedule, based on analysis of operations costs and other factors; and

WHEREAS, the rates proposed by this Ordinance will sustain the activities authorized under Chapter 42.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. Chapter 42, Emergency Services – Appendix C is amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strike through~~ indicates deleted text):

Section 2. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective beginning April 1, 2026, said date being at least ten days after publication of this ordinance.

Section 3. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 4. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
