

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$390,000 WITH PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS FOR THE SH 123 EXPANSION UTILITY RELOCATION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, in June 2024 the City was notified by TxDOT or its subcontractors that utility relocations are required as part of the SH 123 Expansion Project; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the aggressive construction schedule, this particular contract is eligible for exemption from formal RFQ procurement pursuant to Section 252.022(a)(2) and (a)(4) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the services to be performed by Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project includes utility relocation design; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff negotiated a professional services agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the purposes of the SH 123 Expansion Utility Relocation Project; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff recommends entering into a professional services agreement for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in an amount of \$390,000 with Pape-Dawson Engineers for professional services for SH 123 Expansion Utility Relocation Project.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute an agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the SH 123 Expansion Utility Relocation Project.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to execute services amendments within contingency as allowed.

**SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
