A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDED A BID TO THE JIMMY EVANS COMPANY FOR THE PECAN ORCHARD 12 INCH SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN PROJECT AND APPROVING STAFF'S NEGOTIATION A CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$424,913.50 FOR THAT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NEGOTIATED CONTRACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Pecan Orchard 12 Inch Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project (the "Project") is being constructed to replace the old Spring Hill Waste Water Treatment Plant south of the Guadalupe River; and

WHEREAS, nine companies submitted responses to the City's request for proposals to construct the project; and

WHEREAS, the bids ranged from a low base bid of \$424,913.50 from the Jimmy Evans Company of Austin to a high base bid of \$709,051.00 from Black Castle General Contractor; and

WHEREAS, city staff long with Craig Bell of TRC reviewed the bids and the references of the low bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects and bid amount city staff recommends awarding the bid to the Jimmy Evans Company; and

WHEREAS, city staff will negotiate a standard form contact in an amount not to exceed \$424,913.50 for execution by the Jimmy Evans Company.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The Jimmy Evans Company is awarded the bid in an amount not to exceed \$ 424,913.50 for the Pecan Orchard 12 Inch Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project

SECTION 2. The city manager is authorized to execute a standard form contract with the Jimmy Evans Company for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
