A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY TRUSTEE OF THE JACOB DONAVAN BOECK TRUST FOR TWO PARCELS OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID NO.'S 65665 AND 65666 ALONG KINGSBUIRY RD, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Trustee of The Jacob Donovan Boeck Trust filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for two parcels of land with Property ID No.'s 65665 and 65666, totaling approximately 50.07-acres of land located on Kingsbury Rd, Kingsbury, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Trustee of The Jacob Donovan Boeck Trust have presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

WHEREAS, the Petition submitted by Trustee of The Jacob Donovan Boeck Trust meets the requisites of the new law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. The Petition for release of two parcels of land owned by Trustee of The Jacob Donovan Boeck Trust is accepted.

PART 2. The parcels of land being 50.07-acres situated in the J B Johnson Survey, A-191, Property ID No.'s 65665 and 65666, and as more particularly described in the property maps, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.

PART 3. City staff are hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

PART 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning June 19, 2024.
