# **Historical Background**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has posted a grant opportunity entitled 2025 Transportation Alternatives. If awarded, this funding will improve Community-Based Infrastructure, namely sidewalk improvements to improve safety, access, and mobility in the areas of Barnes Elementary School, AJ Briesemeister Middle School and Texas Lutheran University. The sidewalk improvements in this area will enable students safe passage to school, playground facilities and greenspaces throughout the area.
