**Subject:** Public Hearing and First Reading of an Ordinance of the City Council of Seguin, Texas amending the Seguin Code of Ordinances Chapter 98, Section 98-107, No Parking Zones, to restrict parking on portions of College Street; authorizing City Staff to prepare this Ordinance as a supplement to the City Code of Ordinances; and declaring an effective date.

**Date:** April 7, 2026

### Historical Background

As part of the Seguin ISD Bond 2023, funding was approved for a new baseball and softball complex. The new baseball and softball complex eliminates the need for players and coaches to travel across town to the City of Seguin’s Smokey Joe Field. The baseball and softball fields will share facilities such as a ticket booth, restrooms, and concessions. During project planning and permitting, Seguin ISD worked with the Fire Marshal to determine space for first responders.

City Staff received a request from Seguin ISD consultant team for the indicated approximately 275’ No Parking Zone on the north side of College Street in response to a review request from the Fire Marshal’s Office. On December 3, 2024, a No Parking Zone was established on College Street.



**Action Requested**

At the March 17, 2026 City Council meeting, an ordinance to designate the south side of E College Street from King Street to SH 123 Bypass as a No Parking Zone was discussed. Based on Council direction, additional no parking zones are proposed on the north side of College Street from Lamar Street to SH 123 Bypass.
