

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS FOR THE GUADALUPE STREET
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, management, including collection and direction of stormwater drainage runoff within the City, protects the public health, safety, and welfare of the City's citizens; and

WHEREAS, City Council has adopted a Stormwater Utility Plan to govern the planning and design of stormwater infrastructure and flood risk analysis within the City of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted the Drainage Master Plan as the guiding document and prioritization of stormwater projects in order to reduce flood risk; and

WHEREAS, the Nelda Street Drainage Improvements Project was identified in the Drainage Master Plan as Risk Area K & X; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin provided a grant application for FY27 Community Funding for the construction of the Nelda Street Drainage Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the services to be performed by Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project include planning, engineering, surveying, geotechnical, bidding and construction phase services; and

WHEREAS, City staff have negotiated a professional services agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends entering into a professional services agreement for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$699,700 with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Nelda Street Drainage Improvement Project.

Section 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute an agreement with Pape-Dawson for the Nelda Street Drainage Improvement Project for the base fee of \$673,151.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute additional services within contingency as allowed, up to \$26,549 for a total amount of \$699,700.

Section 4. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
