## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION'S EXPENDITURE OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION COST OVERAGES RELATED TO THE LAWSON STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, in conjunction with Tyson Foods, Inc. ("Tyson") expansion project for their manufacturing facility on Kingsbury, the City and SEDC obtained a \$1,000,000.00 grant from the Texas Department of Agriculture for an expansion and reconstruction of Lawson Street from Kingsbury to C.H. Mathies Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, Tyson has agreed to pay for design and engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$172,950.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the engineer's probable cost of construction is \$1,400,000.00, with the City providing a required match and with additional funds not to exceed \$1,100,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and the SEDC have entered into a memorandum of understanding with regard to managing and funding the project; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 25, 2022, the Board of Directors for the Seguin Economic Development Corporation approved SEDC Resolution 2022-12 to fund up to \$400,000.00 for the cost of construction overages for the Lawson Street Project.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** The City Council approves the expenditure of not more than \$400,000.00 by the Seguin Economic Development Corporation to cover additional construction expenses for the Lawson Street Project.
