## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND TYSON FARMS, INC. AS PART OF THE TEXAS RURAL BUSINESS FUND PILOT GRANT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded a \$1,000,000.00 grant from the Texas Rural Business Fund to support the expansion of the Tyson Farms plant in Seguin through improving infrastructure by the reconstruction of Lawson Street from Kingsbury Street to C.H. Mathies Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant requires that the City of Seguin enter into a performance agreement with Tyson Foods to insure that Tyson retain 546 full-time jobs as well as create forty additional jobs during the grant period; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant requires certain reporting by Tyson to support the performance agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant also requires that the City provide \$100,000.00 in matching funds for the Lawson Street reconstruction project; and

**WHEREAS**, the SEDC staff will monitor the performance agreement and staff recommends that the Agreement be approved.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** The City Council approves the attached Agreement with Tyson Farms, Inc. as required by the Texas Rural Business Fund Pilot Program Grant.

**PART TWO.** The city manager is authorized to execute the attached Agreement with Tyson Farms and any other related documents.

**PART THREE**. This resolution is effective from and after the date of its passage.
