STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE AWARD OF NINE FIX-IT FAÇADE GRANTS FOR THE 2023 FISCAL YEAR; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the FY2023 budgeted funding for the FIX-IT Façade Grant program is \$50,389.37; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of these funds is to assist in the restoration of buildings in Seguin's downtown historic district; and

WHEREAS, at their November 21, 2022, meeting the Main Street Advisory Board reviewed the applications for these funds and recommended that the following nine projects be funded, for a total of \$49,949.59:

- **1.)** 106 West Court Street: 33% of the project costs, not to exceed \$2,789.16 of a project estimated at \$8,452.00 to repair the façade.
- **2.)**420 North Austin Street: 50% of the project costs, not to exceed \$825.00 of a project estimated at \$1,650.00 to convert a window to a door.
- **3.)**200 East Court Street: 40% of the project costs, not to exceed \$8000.00 of a project estimated over \$20,000 to reconstruct canopies and repair and replace missing windows.
- **4.)**110 South Austin Street: 33% of the project costs, not to exceed \$5,560.50 of a project estimated at \$16,850.00 to construct a new awning.
- **5.)** 109 113 North Austin Street: 50% of the project costs, not to exceed \$1,969.58 of a project estimated at \$3,939.15 to repair wooden window frames.
- **6.)** 104 South Austin Street: 40% of the project costs, not to exceed \$8,000 of a project estimated over \$20,000 to install a roof membrane system.
- **7.)** 314 North Austin Street: 33% of the project costs, not to exceed \$6,805.35 of a project estimated at \$20,622.28 to replace the roof.
- **8.)**206 South Austin Street: 40% of the project costs, not to exceed \$8,000 of a project estimated over \$20,000 to construct a new awning with recessed lighting.
- **9.)**409 North Austin Street: 40% of the project costs, not to exceed \$8,000 of a project estimated over \$20,000 to repair balconies and replace vinyl windows.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Seguin as follows:

Part One. The recommendations of the Main Street Advisory Board as set forth in the above recitals are hereby approved.

Part Two. This Resolution is in effect from and after the date of its passing.
