A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING PURCHASE OF A 2024 GMC 2500 COMMAND VEHICLE FROM GUNN AUTO GROUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,503.75, WITH FARRWEST SPECIALTY VEHICLES AS THE UPFITTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,943.58, UTILIZING THE BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Fire Department was authorized by Council to replace the shift commander's vehicle during the budget process; and

WHEREAS, this vehicle is a mobile office that can manage incidents ranging from basic medical calls to multi-alarm fires and serves as the command post for all emergency incidents (Fire, LE, EMS.); and

WHEREAS, a committee formed by the Fire Department evaluated several vehicle models and recommends the purchase of a 2024 GMC 2500 Command Vehicle with Farrwest Specialty Equipment as the upfitter; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle selected is available on BuyBoard, which is the website for the Local Government Purchasing Cooperative administered by the Texas Association of School Boards as a means of complying with state bidding requirements that allows local governments the benefit of volume discount pricing and an expedited procurement process; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends purchasing said vehicle from Gunn Auto Group in the amount of \$62,503.75 with Farrwest Specialty Group as the upfitter in the amount of \$48,943.58, through BuyBoard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas as follows:

PART ONE: The City Council hereby approves the purchase of one 2024 GMC 2500 Command Vehicle Gunn Auto Group in the amount of \$62,503.75 with Farrwest Specialty Group as the upfitter in the amount of \$48,943.58, through BuyBoard.

PART TWO: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the purchase of said vehicle.

PART THREE: This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
