A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION HELD ON JANUARY 3, 2023, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER FOR DISTRICT 8; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2022, the City Council canvassed the returns for the November 8, 2022, regular election and therein determined that no candidate for Council Member District 8 received a majority of the votes and, therefore, a runoff election was necessary to elect a council member for District 8; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2022, Edward “Eddie” Davila, Jr. and Bill Keller were certified as candidates for a run-off election and the City Council ordered that a runoff Election be held on January 3, 2023, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member for District 8; and

WHEREAS, notice of the runoff election was duly published in the Seguin Gazette on December 18, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Affidavit of Posting Notice for the election was posted on the bulletin board at City Hall on December 9, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this election was duly and legally held on January 3, 2023, in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the election have been certified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas has today considered the returns of the runoff election held on January 3, 2023, with the following members present: Mayor Donna Dodgen, Joe Rea, Sonia Mendez, Jim Lievens, Chris Rangel, Paul Gaytan, Monica Carter, Jason Biesenbach, and Mark Herbold; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and the Council finds, that the election was in all respects lawfully held; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and Council finds, that the tabulation of the results of the election is correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The runoff election of January 3, 2023, was duly called, notice of the election was given in accordance with law, and the election was held in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. The tabulation of votes cast in the runoff election held on January 3, 2023, for the purposes stated in the Recitals above, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A, is adopted as the official tabulation of the votes cast at the election, and the tabulation will be filed and recorded in the official records of the City of Seguin as the official canvass of the election.

SECTION 3. The official canvass of the returns of the runoff election for City Council District 8 reflects the following:

Bill Keller	342

SECTION 4. That Bill Keller received a majority of the votes and is elected to serve as City Council Member for District 8.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
