**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2023 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES CALL FOR PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin is desiring to improve safety, access, and mobility for people of all ages; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is seeking funds for sidewalk improvements around Joe Carrillo Boulevard Street and Countryside Boulevard and adjoining sidewalks to Koennecke Elementary School and Jim Barnes Middle School; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is submitting a grant application in response to the 2023 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects that will not exceed \$2 million and will not require matching funds ; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1:** The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the 2023 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects for the sidewalk improvements around Joe Carrillo Boulevard Street and Countryside Boulevard and adjoining sidewalks to Koennecke Elementary School and Jim Barnes Middle School.

**SECTION 2:** The City Council reaffirms, directs, and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application, including the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 3:** Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Transportation Alternatives guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Texas Department of Transportation.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
