The 2023 Street Maintenance Plan includes chip seal maintenance for approximately 77,584 square yards of street improvements. The streets and application process are as follows:

On March 28, 2023, a bid opening was held with three bids received. The bids ranged from a low bid of \$334,684.00 from Lone Star Paving, San Antonio, Texas, to a high bid of \$617,579.80, from Gage & Cade Construction, Bertram, Texas.

Staff recommends project award to the low bid received from Lone Star Paving of San Antonio, Texas, in the amount of \$334,684.00. Lone Star Paving has been awarded the chip seal maintenance contract for the city in years 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2022. Their workmanship has been favorable.

Funding will come from the FY2023 Chip Seal Project Fund and the remaining funds available from last year's balance. Staff will be available to answer any questions.
