The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requires retail public water suppliers with more than 3,300 connections to develop and submit an updated Drought Contingency and Water Emergency Response Plan every five years.

The 2014 Drought Contingency and Water Emergency Response Plan is to provide procedures for voluntary and mandatory action to be placed into effect to temporarily reduce the demand placed upon the City of Seguin's water supply system during a water-shortage emergency and to promote conservation practices.
