

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE SEGUIN THOROUGHFARE PLAN  
AND THE NEW BRAUNFELS – SEGUIN REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support and administer transportation management plans that enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Seguin and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support such transportation management plans for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Seguin and the ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan in conjunction with the Comprehensive Master Plan on October 21, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan on August 16, 2011; and

WHEREAS, proposed and existing developments support the following amendment:

1. The realignment of the northwestern segment of the Outer Loop (between Rudeloff and Huber Roads) and its increase of Right-of-Way width from 180 to 200 feet.

WHEREAS, the Long Range Planning Committee and the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the amendment to the Plans and recommended approval of the amendment as presented herein and as shown on the attached Exhibit A; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

That the City Council of Seguin, Texas approves the amendments to the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan and the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan, as presented herein and as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
