Subject: Guadalupe County Interlocal Agreement – N. Guadalupe Street

Date: September 15, 2016

Guadalupe County Road Department is requesting to provide street improvements on North Guadalupe Street (approximately 3,696 feet) just north of the Guadalupe County Jail Facility and within the city limits of Seguin.

Guadalupe County requests to provide the following street improvements on North Guadalupe Street:

- Mill existing pavement
- Reshape the contour line of the street
- Grade and crosslope street
- Stabilize the street using P2 Stabilizer
- Compact to finish grade and prime

In addition, Guadalupe County offers the use of their equipment and manpower for the proposed improvements in exchange for compensation of materials costs in the amount of \$37,915, as indicated in the attached photo and proposal breakdown.

Public Works staff and management have evaluated the proposal and have deemed the cost an excellent value and maintenance improvement for the street. The work will also relieve City manpower from undertaking this improvement and street maintenance. The improvement does comply with the City's design standards for street maintenance improvements.

Staff recommends approval of the attached Interlocal Agreement and resolution for the improvements. Funding will come from the Public Works FY2016 Street Maintenance account.
