AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX C – FEE SCHEDULE, CHAPTER 74, PARKS AND RECREATION – MAX STARCKE PARK GOLF COURSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, after the Fiscal Year 2017 budget process and input from users staff reviewed the fees and memberships for the Max Starcke Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fee changes are a good balance between meeting the City's needs while maintaining affordable play for the golf course users.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. Appendix C – Fee Schedule, Chapter 74, Parks and Recreation, Subsection (a), Max Starcke Park Golf Course, of the Seguin Code of Ordinances is amended with the changes, additions, and reorganization to the existing list (all sections not appearing below remain unchanged) as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text):

(a) Max Starcke Park Golf Course:

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective beginning October 1, 2016, said date being at least ten days after publication of this ordinance.

Section 3. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 4. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
