Re: Issuance of Certificates of Obligation

As a continuation of the City Council's plan to make improvements to existing streets, and initiate major street reconstruction projects leveraging MPO funding whenever possible, the City Council included \$10,304,134 in the FY2017 budget for street projects. These projects include:

These projects total \$10,304,134; however City Council approved in the FY2017 Budget issuing \$8,800,000 in Certificates of Obligation to fund the projects with the remaining balance be funded by carry over funds from the FY2016 Street Project Funding.

At this meeting our financial advisors, Duane and Alan Westerman of SAMCO, will be present as we request approval to begin the issuance of \$8,800,000 in Certificates of Obligation. Proceeds would be received before the end of the calendar year. The major Tor MPO project is planned to be bid in early first quarter of 2017.
