## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION'S EXPENDITURE OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT SATELLITE CENTER BY THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT SAN ANTONIO

WHEREAS, the University of Texas at San Antonio's Center for Community and Business Research Institute for Economic Development ("UTSA") has implemented a Small Business Development Satellite Center ("SBDC Satellite") with the goal of providing no-cost business advising and training services to local businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the SBDC Satellite serves, on an equal basis, the communities of Seguin and New Braunfels; and

**WHEREAS**, UTSA has requested continued annual funding from Seguin and New Braunfels to continue funding for the SBDC Satellite; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 6, 2016, the Board of Directors for the Seguin Economic Development Corporation decided that the SBDC Satellite program was a valuable asset and approved, by Resolution SEDC 16-10, an expenditure of supporting funds in the amount not to exceed \$60,000.00.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** The City Council approves the expenditure of not more than \$60,000.00 by the Seguin Economic Development Corporation for UTSA to continue the operation of the Small Business Development Satellite Center.
