## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS ADOPTING LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN RELATING TO THE POSSIBLE CREATION OF ROADWAY IMPACT FEES

**WHEREAS,** on October 10, 2016, the Impact Fee Advisory Committee reviewed and evaluated the Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvements Plan for the City of Seguin in accordance with the Texas Local Government Code Sec. 395.050; and

**WHEREAS**, the Impact Fee Advisory Committee recommends approval of the Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvements Plan as presented and included in the Sections 2A and 2B of the draft Roadway Impact Fee Study for the City of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvements Plan with written findings and recommendation of the Impact Fee Advisory Committee was submitted to City Council; and

**WHEREAS,** on December 6, 2016, the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas held a public hearing to receive public comment concerning Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvement Plan and the imposition of an impact fee for roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, the public notice of such hearing was made at least 30 days in advance of the hearing according to legal criteria set forth in Chapter 395.055 of the Texas Local Government Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT** resolved by the city council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**Part 1.** The City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas hereby adopts by resolution Sections 2A and 2B of the draft Roadway Impact Fee Study - Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvement Plan.
