A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TRC SOLUTIONS FOR DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO A NEW LIFT STATION AND FORCE MAIN TO REPLACE THE SPRINGS HILL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND THE ABANDONMENT AND DEMOLITION OF THAT PLANT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in order to provide more cost effective service to its customers the City is purchasing the Springs Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant (the “Plant”) from GBRA; and

WHEREAS, the Plant’s current capacity is not sufficient to handle the City’s anticipated growth south of the Guadalupe River; and

WHEREAS, the Plant is located within a flood zone such that it would be necessary to build an entire new plant in order to meet the City’s anticipated needs; and

WHEREAS, the Walnut Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant has ample capacity to serve the City’s customers south of the Guadalupe River; and

WHEREAS, building a lift station with a force main to the Walnut Branch Plant is the most efficient and cost effective means for providing such service; and

WHEREAS, TRC Solutions, who is familiar with the area and the City’s wastewater treatment plants, has provided a proposal in the amount of \$365,386.00, for engineering services necessary to decommission the Plant and design and build a lift station and force main so that the Walnut Branch Plant can serve the area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves entering into a Professional Services Agreement with TRC Solutions in the amount of \$364,386.00 for the design and engineering services necessary to replace the Springs Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant with a lift station and force main to the Walnut Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with TRC Solutions for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
