## **CITY OF SEGUIN**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS CREATING A NO PARKING ZONE AND A STOPPING ONLY ZONE ON PARTS OF HERITAGE DRIVE IN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City has received numerous complaints from residents of the Heritage South Subdivision concerning parked vehicles on Heritage Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer has studied the parking impact on Heritage Drive, particularly how parking effects sight distance for traffic exiting the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, parked traffic also impedes use of the subdivision's mailbox cluster.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council adopts the findings of the City Engineer and restricts parking on parts of Heritage Drive as follows:

(a) A no parking zone is established on both sides of Heritage drive from FM 466 (South King Street) to a point 120 feet south of the edge of pavement on FM 466.

(b) A Resident restricted stopping only zone on the west side of Heritage Drive from a point 250 feet south of FM 466 (South King Street) to a point 320 feet south of FM 466.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby directs the public works manager to erect the appropriate signs in the areas indicated in Section 1, and as shown on the attached map.

**SECTION 3.** The changes in parking made by this Ordinance shall be effective on and after the day the appropriate signs are erected.
